Larry asked for a raise in hands for those who wanted to keep the dues at \$25. A unanimous number of hands were in favor of keeping the dues at \$25.

The LAPPOA membership dues will remain at \$25 for the next year.

Members were asked to encourage non-participating neighbors to join.

Agenda item 3 – Dumpsters

Approved for the following year was the rental of either 2 - 15 yard dumpsters or 1 - 30 yard dumpster to be put in a central location somewhere in the neighborhood. The agreement was to have 30 yards of non-toxic waste dumpster(s) twice a year, at Memorial Day and Labor Day. John Larsen will be in charge of the rental and placement of the dumpster(s).
